

Our Combined Asylum Attorney Fee program

In response to the changing face of Asylum relief in the Orlando court, and all other Immigration Courts, we are introducing the **Combined Attorney Fee** structure for Asylum clients.

Immigration judges are deciding more and more against Asylum applicants on many different grounds. We have been successful in appealing judges decisions and providing to clients a legal challenge to erred decisions by Immigration judges; as well as gaining additional time for the client to lawfully remain in the U.S. while the appeal process is in place. Currently the appeal process is adding an additional six to nine months to the approximately eighteen months time that the asylum case takes in the Immigration court.

Because of the limited time the court provides to appeal a judges decision, we encourage clients to be prepared for appeal and to that extent we are offering a 33% discount to hiring this office to handle both courts up front.

Payment choice One

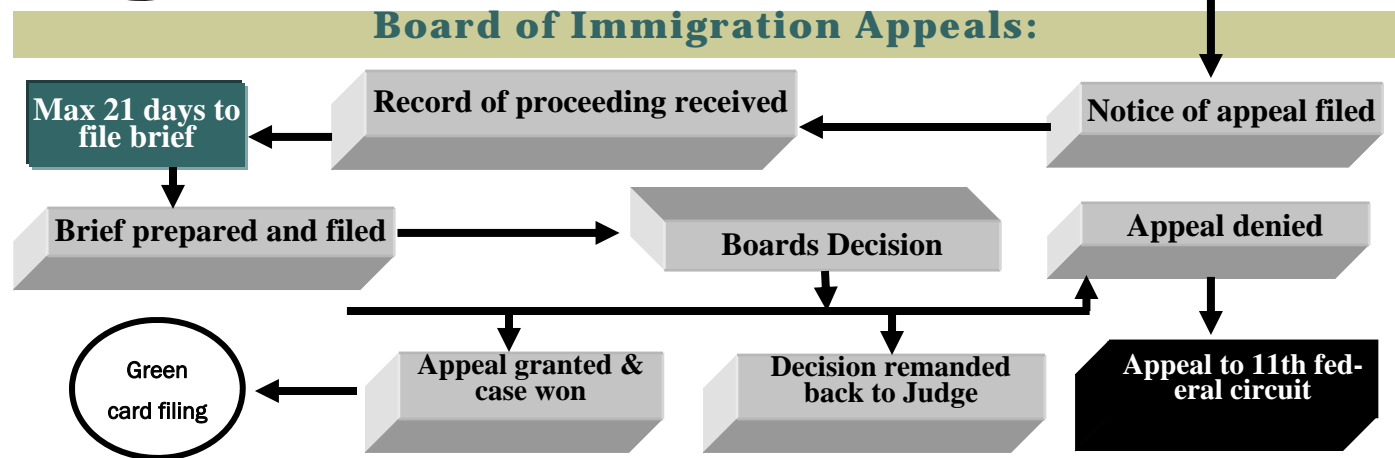
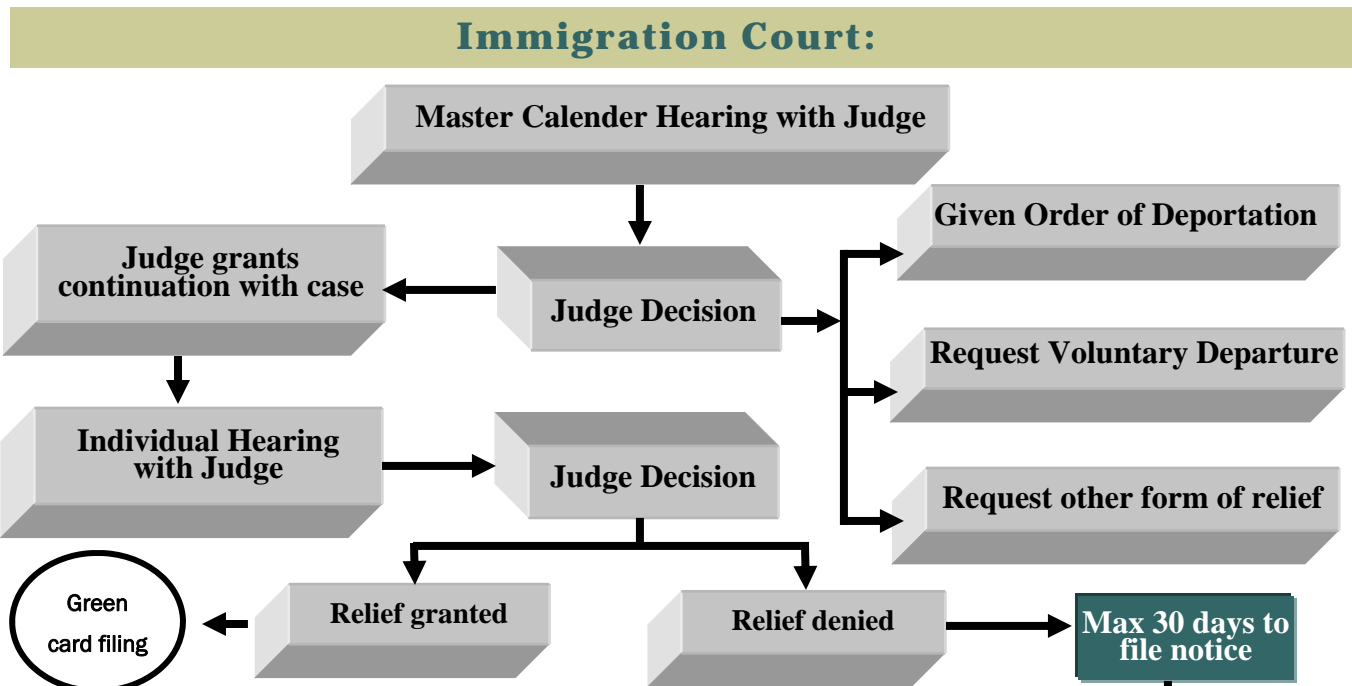
Hiring our office in two steps: once for court representation; and if the Asylum case is not granted, hiring our office to file the BIA appeal; the combined cost is: \$6,000

Payment choice TWO

Hiring our office up front to represent you in both courts results in a 33% discount. Additionally, if our work in the immigration court results in a grant of Asylum, a \$500 credit will be applied towards the \$1,500 Adjustment of Status attorney fee which this office can handle for you one year after the Asylum is approved.
